lying at anchor,

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
Middle and latter parts the same employed in
stowing of the main hatch took on board
17 tons stone Balast Ship lying at anchor

Remarks On Board Sunday May 10th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
finished stowing the main hatch with balast
Middle and latter part fine weather Ship lying
at anchor with starboard hatch a shore on
liberty,

Remarks On Board Monday May 11th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
Middle and latter parts the same all hands
employed in breaking out Oil,

Remarks On Board Tuesday May 12th 1847

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
landed on shore 3040 Gallons of Whale Oil
Middle and latter parts fine weather Ship
lying at anchor employed in breaking out
the After hatch to stow Balast,

Remarks On Board Wednesday May 13th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather took
on board 10 tons stone balast, Middle and latter
parts fine weather took in 10 tons of Balast employ
in stowing the same in after hold,

Remarks On Board Thursday May 14th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather took
on board 10 tons balast Middle and latter parts
fine weather employed in stowing the hold
Ship lying at anchor,

Remarks On Board Friday May 15th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
Middle and latter parts the same took on board
16 tons of Wood employed in stowing the
hold Ship lying at anchor,

Remarks On Board Saturday May 16th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather
Middle and latter parts the same took
on board 9 tons balast Ship lying at anchor
