

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 24th 1857

First part of these 24 hours light air and
barbours. Middle and latter parts the same
with foggy weather most of the time
overshining Ship to East. Lat Arcou 44.00 S
Long Do 166.00 E

Remarks On Board Thursday June 25th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze
from West and variable with squalls of fog
Middle and latter parts the same steering
Ship S by N. Lat of Obs 43.36 S
Long by Account 168.00 E

Remarks On Board Friday June 26th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from
South steering East at 9 PM Lt Ship came too
on a wind heading to SE with the main yard
aback at 6 AM steered Ship East 10 AM saw New
Zealand Island bearing SE 45 miles distance
latter part strong breeze from NNE ship heading
towards the land,

Remarks On Board Saturday June 27th

First part of these 24 hours light winds
from SE and pleasant Middle part strong
gales with rain took in fore and mizen
top sails latter part gentle breeze and variable
the land in sight to the East 15 miles distance
Lat of Obs 44.27 S

Remarks On Board Sunday June 28th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from SE
and pleasant Middle & latter parts the same
the land bearing East 10 miles distance two
boats in shore fishing 2 sails in sight
Lat Account 44.30 S

Remarks On Board Monday June 29th 1857

First part of these 24 hours light winds
and variable Middle and latter parts
light winds and variable with squalls
of rain New Zealand in sight to the East
30 miles distance Lat of Obs 44.37 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 30th

First part of these 24 hours light winds
from SE and pleasant Middle and latter
parts gentle breeze from North ship on different
tasks cruising New Zealand in sight to the
East 30 miles distance employed in stowing
oil in after hatch, several sails in sight

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 1st

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
from NNE Middle part the same latter
part gentle gale and drizzly weather spoke
Barque Pacific of New Bedford with 450 bbls
of sperm, Lat of Obs 44.45 S

Remarks On Board Thursday July 2nd

First part of these 24 hours fresh gales with
thick weather took in fore and mizen
top sails let ship by two under a close reef
main top sail Middle and latter parts
the same

Remarks On Board Friday July 3rd

First part of these 24 hours fresh gale from
SE with thick and rainy weather Middle part
more moderate latter part strong breeze
from SE and squally ship cruising
Lat of Obs 45.05 S
