

Remarks On Board Sunday July 12th 1847

First part of these 24 hours light winds and variable. Middle and latter parts pleasant weather. New Zealand in sight to the East 5 miles. Distance about in shore fishing. Lat Obs 44.28 S

Remarks On Board Monday July 13th

First part of these 24 hours light air and calm. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breeze from SE ship heading on a wind to the SW. Lat 44.45 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 14th

First part of these 24 hours light winds and variable. Middle and latter parts gentle gales from SE with clear weather. Ship on different tack the land in sight to East 35 miles. Distance, Lat 45.10 S

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 15th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from SE. Middle and latter parts light air and calm with fine weather. New Zealand in sight to the East 30 miles. Distance. Lat 45.07 S

Remarks On Board Thursday July 16th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from South with clear weather. Middle and latter parts the same. Ship on different tack. New Zealand in sight to the East 10 miles. Distance. Lat 45.07 S

Remarks On Board Friday July 17th 1847

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from South with clear weather. Middle part light air. Latter part gentle breeze from the North with squalls of fog. New Zealand in sight to the East 20 miles. Distance.

Lat 45.00 S

Remarks On Board Saturday July 18th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the North steering Ship South at 6 PM. Let ship come to on a wind to the West off shore under short sail. Middle part fresh gales with rain. Latter part light air from West with clear weather. The land in sight to the East 20 miles. Distance.

Lat Obs 46.00 S

Remarks On Board Sunday July 19th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from West with pleasant weather. Middle and latter parts the same steering Ship different courses. New Zealand in sight to North. Solander's Island bearing SE 3/4 W 14 miles. Distance.

Lat 46.24 S

Long 166.45 E

Remarks On Board Monday July 20th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from West with pleasant weather steering Ship to South. Middle part the same at 2 PM. Let ship come to on a wind heading off shore with main yard aback at 7 PM. Steered Ship to the East. Latter part strong breeze from NW steering to Island in sight to the North 10 miles. Distance.
