

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 21st 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from West and squally steering Ship to NE along the East side of Stewart Island Middle part light air and variable Latter part light winds from West and pleasant steering Ship to NE New Deland in sight to North 4 miles Distance
Lat 46.00 S

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 22^d

First part of these 24 hours light winds from West with fine weather Middle and Latter parts the same steering Ship to NE along with the Land 3 boats in shore cruising for Right Whales

Remarks On Board Thursday July 23^d

First part of these 24 hours light winds and variable Middle part gentle breeze from NW Latter part light air and calm steering Ship to North New Deland in sight to the West 14 miles Distance Cape Saunders bearing NW 40 miles Distance

Remarks On Board Friday July 24th

First part of these 24 hours light air and calm Middle and Latter parts the same with fine weather Cape Saunders in sight to NE 14 miles Distance,

Remarks On Board Saturday July 25th 1857

First part of these 24 hours light air from North and pleasant Middle and Latter part light air and variable with fine weather Ship on different tack working to NE Cape Saunders bearing West 7 miles Distance

Remarks On Board Sunday July 26th

First part of these 24 hours light winds and variable at 4 PM Otago bearing West 4 miles Distance a boat came on board from shore Middle and Latter parts light air and variable with calm working Ship to North along shore,

Remarks On Board Monday July 27th

First part of these 24 hours light air and variable Middle part strong breeze from NW Latter part fresh gales and squally New Deland bearing West 5 miles steering Ship along with the Land to NE under reefed Top Sails

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 28th

First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from NW and squally Ship under reefed Top Sails steering to NE along with the Land at 5 PM heavy gales but Ship came to on a wind with a reefed main Top Sail heading to SE off shore Middle and Latter parts heavy gales Ship lying to the Land in sight Heavier bearing NW 16 miles Distance
