

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 29th 1884

First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from S.W. Ship lying too under a close reefed Main Top Sail heading to S.E. Middle part the same at 6 AM veered Ship to West latter part gentle gales and clear weather set Fore Sail then Relanded in sight of shore bearing N.W. 35 miles Distance

Remarks On Board Thursday July 30th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from S.W. set doubled reefed Top Sails Middle and latter parts light airs and calms Bankers Peninsula bearing South 7 miles Distance

Remarks On Board Friday July 31st

First part of these 24 hours light winds and variable Middle part the same Ship on different tack at 8 AM fresh breeze from S.W. Bankers Peninsula bearing West 7 miles Distance steered Ship off East latter part the same

Remarks On Board Saturday August 1st

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from S.E. Middle and latter parts strong breezes from East Ship on different tack working to the East

Remarks On Board Sunday August 2nd 1884

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from East and veered at 6 PM shortened sail Middle and latter parts gentle gales from East with thick drizzly weather Ship under short sail heading North

Remarks On Board Monday August 3rd

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from East with rain Middle and latter parts strong breezes from West and rainy steering Ship East

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 4th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from S.W. and squally Middle and latter parts the same steering Ship East under short sail

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 5th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales with squalls of rain Middle part the same Ship lying too latter part more moderate wind from South steering Ship under doubled reefs

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from S.E. Middle and latter parts gentle breeze from S.E. and cloudy Ship on different tack
