Middle and latter parts strong breezes from West
to NW Ship heading on a wind to North

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from NE
with rain at 6 PM took in sail let ship by too
under a close reefed Main Top Sail and fore sail
heading to East Middle part the same latter part
strong breezes and heavy ship heading on a wind
to the West

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 25th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from
NNW and heavy Middle part gentle gales from
NNW with showers of rain Ship heading on
a wind to NNW under doubled reefs latter
part the same

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 26th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from
West and rugged ship heading on a wind to
NNW under short sail Middle and latter
parts gentle breezes from WNW Ship heading on
a wind to NW by N under all sail

Remarks On Board Thursday August 27th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from SSW
Middle and latter parts the same with fine
weather steering Ship West under all sail

Remarks On Board Friday August 28th 1847

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from
NE with fine weather steering Ship SW latter
part strong breezes with rain steering Ship SW
by W under all sail

Lat 34.30 S
Long 174.40 E

Remarks On Board Saturday August 29th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from East with
rain steering Ship SW at 5 PM ran Cape Breton
New Zealand bearing SSW 25 miles Distance
reefed the Top Sails at 9 PM veered ship to NW
Middle part strong breezes and squally at 3 PM veered
ship to SSW latter part strong breezes with squalls
of rain steering Ship along with the Land to the
West

Long 173.45 E

Remarks On Board Sunday August 30th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from
SW and squally steering Ship to the West
along with the Land Middle part gentle gales
and squally North Cape of New Zealand in sight
bearing SW 15 miles Distance at 3 PM fresh gales
with rain took in sail let ship by too under a close
reefed Main Top Sail heading off shore to the North
latter part the same,

Lat 33.45 S
Long 172.25 E

Remarks On Board Monday August 31st

First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from East with
rain Ship lying too under a close reefed Main Top
Sail Middle part the same latter part gentle breezes
and pleasant the three kites in sight to SSW 25
miles Distance
