First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from S & and squally at 6 pm shortened sail Middle and latter parts fresh gales from S & and ragged ship lying too under a close reefed main top sail heading to S & W,

Remarks On Board Wednesday September 2^d
First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from South Middle and latter parts strong breezes with clear weather ship heading on a wind to the S & W

Lat 34.00 S

Long 170.45 E

Remarks On Board Thursday September 3^d

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes with pleasant weather Middle and latter parts gentle breezes from S & with fine weather ship on different tack cruising

Lat 34.20 S

Long 170.10 E

Remarks On Board Friday September 4th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from South with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same ship on different tack

Lat 34.00 S

Remarks On Board Saturday September 5th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from N & W with fine weather Middle part strong breezes from N & and ragged at 9 AM saw a school of sperm whales lured boat and fastened to one side and took it to ship, latter part ragged with a bad sea on

Remarks On Board Sunday September 6th 1857

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from N & and ragged at 2 PM commenced cutting at 7 PM finished cutting the whale Middle part rainy latter part strong breezes from North ship under short sail

Remarks On Board Monday September 7th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from North and ragged Middle and latter parts the same ship on different tack cruising

Lat 34.00 S

Long 170.05 E

Remarks On Board Tuesday September 8th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from N & W and squally Middle and latter parts gentle breezes with fine weather ship on different tack cruising, employed in looking.

Lat 34.15 S

Long 171.30 E

Remarks On Board Wednesday September 9th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from N & W with fine weather at 2 PM saw a school of sperm whales lured boat fastened to one side and took it to ship at 4 PM Middle part strong breeze and rainy at 7 PM commenced cutting latter part rainy finished cutting the whale

Remarks On Board Thursday September 10th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from East with rain Middle and latter parts gentle gales and ragged ship under short sail,
