First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from East with rain Middle and latter parts gentle breezes with pleasant weather employed in looking the three Kings in sight to the East,

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant Middle and latter part strong breezes and variable with squalls Ship under short sail finished boiling

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from West and squally Middle and latter parts the same ship lying too under a close reefed Main Top Sail

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from SW and squally Middle and latter parts strong breezes and rugged employed in stowing oil in after hold.

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SW Middle and latter parts more moderate ship under short sail employed in stowing oil in after hold

Remarks On Board Monday September 28th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from South and rugged Middle part gentle gales ship lying too under short sail latter part the same steering ship WNW under doubled reefs

Lat 32.40 S

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from South and rugged at 7 PM shortened sail Middle and latter parts more moderate steering ship WNW under all sail.
