First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from North with pleasant weather Ship lying off and on to East of Norfolk Island at 4 AM steered Ship off SE mile and latter parts gentle breeze with pleasant weather steering Ship SSB,

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from NE with fine weather mile and latter parts strong breeze from North and regged Ship under doubled reefs on different tacks cruising

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from North with squalls of rain mile and latter parts strong breeze from West with pleasant weather Ship on different tacks cruising

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from SSW and squally mile and latter parts gentle gales and squally Ship under short rail heading to SSW

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from SSW and squally mile part the same latter part strong breeze from SSW with fine weather Ship heading on different tacks cruising saw an English Merchant Ship steering to the North

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from SSW mile and latter parts gentle gales and squally Ship under short sail on different tacks
