

Remarks On Board Monday October 19th 1857

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from SSW and rugged Middle and latter parts the same ship under short sail the three Kings in sight to S 88 34 miles distance

Remarks On Board Tuesday October 20th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from SSW and squally Middle and latter parts strong breezes and squally ship in different tacks cruising

Remarks On Board Wednesday October 21st

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from South Middle part light airs and variable latter part strong breezes from S 88 a school of sperm whales in sight a head 3 miles distance

Remarks On Board Thursday October 22^d

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes and rugged lured boats and fastened to one sperm whale killed and took it to ship at 2 P.M. commenced cutting the whale run down under water the hook tore out Middle part strong breezes from North and rugged the whale lying along side at 6 A.M. commenced cutting at 8 finished latter part strong breezes and rugged ship under short sail

Remarks On Board Friday October 23^d 1857

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales with thick and smoky weather wind from N 88 Middle and latter parts strong breezes with thick and smoky ship in different tacks cruising

Remarks On Board Saturday October 24th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SSW and smoky at 3 P.M. ran the three Kings bearing S 88 12 miles distance vessel ship to S 88 S 88 Middle and latter parts gentle breezes and foggy most of the time ship heading on a wind to West employed in boiling

Remarks On Board Sunday October 25th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from N 88 Middle and latter parts gentle gales from North with rain ship lying too under a close reef Main top sail finished boiling

Remarks On Board Monday October 26th

First part of these 24 hours strong gales from N 88 ship lying too heading to S 88 Middle part the same latter part strong breezes from S 88 ship heading on a wind to S 88 under all sail the three Kings in sight to S 88 20 miles distance
