

Remarks On Board Friday November 13th 1857

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from West and rainy. Middle part strong breezes with clear weather at 4 PM saw several Right Whales lured boats without success. Latter part strong breezes and rugged two ships in sight. Lat Obs 35.46 S
Long Obs 166.40 W

Remarks On Board Saturday November 14th
First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from West with clear weather at 4 PM saw two Right Whales lured boats fastened and killed one took it to ship at 6 PM, saw several more Right Whales. Middle part light winds from North with a heavy swell on the whale lying along side at 6 AM commenced cutting at 9 finished, Latter part strong breezes with hazy weather saw several Right Whales to windward two ships in sight one of them got a whale. Lat Obs 35.44 S
Long Obs 166.30 W

Remarks On Board Sunday November 15th
First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from North with thick and hazy weather and rugged saw several Right Whales to windward Middle and latter parts fresh gales with rain ship lying too under short sail. Lat Obs 36.10 S
Long 166.45 W

Remarks On Board Monday November 16th
First part of these 24 hours fresh gales from NNE ship lying too under short sail. Middle part more moderate. Latter part gentle breezes from SW with fine weather saw no Right Whales employed in boiling two ships in sight. Lat 36.00 S
Long 166.40 W

Remarks On Board Tuesday November 17th 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes SW. Middle and latter parts the same saw three Right Whales to windward two ships in sight one cutting the other whaling, employed in boiling. Lat Obs 36.33 S
Long Obs 166.25 W

Remarks On Board Wednesday November 18th
First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from SW and rugged at 3 PM saw Right Whales lured boats fastened to one killed and took it to ship commenced cutting at 8 PM finished cutting. Middle and latter parts strong breezes and rugged with smoky weather ship on different tasks cruising saw no Right Whales. Lat Obs 36.43 S
Long Obs 166.25 W

Remarks On Board Thursday November 19th
First part of these 24 hours strong breezes and rugged. Middle and latter parts the same ship on different tasks cruising two ships in sight.

Remarks On Board Friday November 20th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from SW with pleasant weather spoke Barge Tover of St. John London 900 lbs of Whale 7 Whales this season. Middle and latter parts light winds from North with fine weather employed in boiling. Lat Obs 36.45 S
Long Obs 166.40 W

Remarks On Board Saturday November 21st
First part of these 24 hours light winds from North with fine weather. Middle part strong breezes and raining. Latter part more moderate ship on different tasks cruising. Lat Obs 36.32 S
