First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from N.E. with squalls of fog Middle and latter parts strong gales from South with a bad sea on Ship lying too under a close reefed main top sail heading to the West Lat Obs 36.52 S

Remarks On Board Monday November 23^d

First part of these 24 hours strong gales from S.W. Middle and latter parts more moderate Ship lying too heading to S.W.

Lat Obs 36.24 S

Long Obs 167.10 W

Remarks On Board Tuesday November 24th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from South with a bad sea on Middle and latter parts gentle breezes with pleasant weather Ship on different courses cruising,

Remarks On Board Wednesday November 25th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from S.W. with a swell on steering Ship to Portward Middle and latter parts gentle breezes from S.W. with fine weather steering Ship on different courses cruising,

Remarks On Board Thursday November 26th

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes from S.W. with pleasant weather saw the Christopher Mitchell take a whale, at 6 PM saw a Right Whale bred boat fastened and killed and took it to Ship at 7 PM Middle part strong breeze at 6 AM commenced cutting at 10 PM finished latter part strong breezes Ship cruising,

Remarks On Board Friday November 27th 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes at 6 PM saw two Right Whales bred boats without success Middle part pleasant at 10 AM saw two Right Whales bred boat fastened to one killed and took it to Ship latter pleasant weather two sails in sight Lat Obs 37.04 S

Remarks On Board Saturday November 28th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from West with fine weather commenced cutting at 4 PM finished Middle and latter parts foggy most of the time employed in boiling,

Remarks On Board Sunday November 29th

First part of these 24 hours light air and variable at 7 PM spoke Bargee Brightons of Dartmouth with 2 Whales this season Middle and latter parts calm with light air finished boiling

Remarks On Board Monday November 30th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from East with fine weather Middle part the same latter part foggy most of the time stopping oil in fore hold,

Remarks On Board Tuesday November 1st

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from N.E. with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same Ship on different tack cruising
