First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same Ship on different tacks cruising

Remarks On Board Thursday December 3<sup>d</sup> 1857

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. with fine weather several ships in sight spoke Ship William and Henry of Fairhaven with 2 Whales this season Middle and latter parts gentle breeze from North saw several Right Whales to windward working Ship up to them,

Remarks On Board Friday December 4<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from N.E. with fine weather saw several Right Whales lured boats fastened to one side and took it to Ship commenced cutting at 7 P.M. finished cutting got Bow Boat stove by the Whale Middle part pleasant at 4 P.M. saw two Right Whales lured boats fastened to one side the Whale run the White boat got stove by the Whale latter part pleasant,

Remarks On Board Saturday December 5<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather saw 2 Right Whales lured boats without success spoke James & Thompson of New Bedford with two Whales this season Middle part foggy latter part light air with fine weather saw two Right Whales lured boats without success employed in boiling

Remarks On Board Sunday December 6<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours fine weather Middle and latter parts the same saw two Right Whales lured boats without success several Ships in sight boiling and two cutting

Remarks On Board Monday December 7<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light air and calm Middle part the same latter part light wind from North with fine weather saw one Right Whale going fast spoke Ship Rambler of New Bedford with three Whales this season and Barque Cleone of New Bedford 2 Whales,

Remarks On Board Tuesday December 8<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from North with fine weather saw a Right Whale going fast lured boats without success Middle and latter parts light winds and fine weather steering Ship South saw 2 Right Whales lured boats without success,

Remarks On Board Wednesday December 9<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light winds from N.W. with fine weather Middle and latter parts gentle breeze from North with fine weather steering Ship South spoke Ship Navigator of Edgarton 2 Whales this season

Remarks On Board Thursday December 10<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from North with fog and rain Middle part the same latter part gentle gale from S.E. Ship under short sail
