First part of these 24 hours gentle gales from East spoke Barque Stromoen of Fairhaven Middle part light winds and pleasant at 9 AM saw a Right Whale lured boat without success Latter part strong breeze and rugged ship on Different tracks cruising

Remarks On Board Saturday December 12th
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and rugged Middle part more moderate at 10 AM saw a Right Whale lured boat and fastened the line got fowl of the Chocks of the boat cut line lost the Whale Latter part strong breeze S.

Remarks On Board Sunday December 13th
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and variable Middle and Latter part gentle gales and variable with squalls of wind and rain Ship lying too under short sail

First part of these 24 hours gentle gales with squally weather Middle part the same Latter strong breeze and squally Ship under short sail

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and rugged Middle and latter part more moderate ship on Different tracks cruising,

Remarks On Board Wednesday December 16th 1854

First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from West Middle and latter part gentle breeze and variable with squalls of rain Ship on Different tracks cruising

Remarks On Board Thursday December 17th
First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze at 2 PM strong breeze with squalls of rain Middle and latter part light winds from S W Ship on Different tracks cruising

Remarks On Board Friday December 18th
First part of these 24 hours fresh breeze with fine weather Middle part the same at 9 AM saw a Right Whale lured boat without success at 11 AM saw two Right Whales lured boats and fastened to one Latter part strong breeze from N W and rugged the Whale spouting blood

Remarks On Board Saturday December 19th
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from N W and rugged at 2 PM took the Whale to the Ship at 4 PM commenced cutting at 8 finished cutting Middle part gentle gales with rain Latter part light winds with fine weather Ship on Different tracks cruising one sail in sight
