

Remarks On Board Tuesday January 5th 1858

First part of these 24 hours heavy gale from SW with a bad sea on Middle part more moderate latter part strong breeze from North with rain 3 ships in sight,

Remarks On Board Wednesday January 6th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from North and variable with squalls of rain at 4 PM saw two Right Whales lured boats without success spoke Barque Midas of New Bedford with 150 bl of sperm also ship Pappan of Fairhaven 1 whale this season 10 ships in sight one cutting Middle part light air and variable latter part gentle breeze from West with fine weather one Right Whale in sight going past ship in "haze"

Remarks On Board Thursday January 7th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from West with a swell on at 2 PM got up with the whale lured boat without success at 4 PM saw a Dead Whale with lips and throat gone with part of a fluke chain on took it along side saved bone and cut the blubber in Middle part gentle breeze with squalls of rain at 11 PM saw two Right Whales lured boat fastened to the two latter part light winds with fine weather the 2 Whales sporting Hood, employed in boiling

Remarks On Board Friday January 8th 1858

First part of these 24 hours light winds with fine weather at 2 PM took the 2 Whales along side the ship at 3 PM commenced cutting at 4 PM finished cutting one whale it raining heavy let the other whale by alongside Middle part rainy at 6 PM commenced cutting at 10 finished latter part fine weather employed in boiling

Remarks On Board Saturday January 9th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze from South Middle part rainy latter part strong breeze with clear weather employed in boiling ship under short sail,

Remarks On Board Sunday January 10th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze with squally weather Middle and latter parts the same employed in boiling

Remarks On Board Monday January 11th

First part of these 24 hours gentle gale with rain Middle and latter parts the same ship under short sail employed in boiling

Lat 48.35 S
Long 161.50 W

Remarks On Board Tuesday January 12th

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from West and squally Middle and latter parts the same employed in boiling
