

Remarks On Board Sunday February 28th 1858

First part of these 24 hours light winds with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same Ship lying at Anchor with Harbour watch a shore on liberty

Remarks On Board Monday March 1st

First part of these 24 hours light winds with fine weather Middle and latter parts the same Ship lying at Anchor all hands employed in storing water &c

Remarks On Board Tuesday March 2^d

First part of these 24 hours light winds and pleasant Middle part the same at 6 AM took the Anchor and towed the ship out the harbor for sea latter part light winds steering ship to South for the Island Upoa

Remarks On Board Wednesday March 3^d

First part of these 24 hours light winds from NE steering ship for Upoa at 4 PM came to Anchor on SW side of Upoa 1 1/2 mile distance from shore Middle and latter parts light winds from NE and squally Ship lying at Anchor

Remarks On Board Thursday March 4th 1858

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from NE and squalls of rain Middle and latter parts the same Ship lying at Anchor employed in getting of Wood from Shore

Remarks On Board Friday March 5th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from NE with pleasant weather Middle and latter parts the same Ship lying at Anchor employed in getting of Wood

Remarks On Board Saturday March 6th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from NE and squally Middle and latter parts the same Ship lying at Anchor

Remarks On Board Sunday March 7th

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from NE and squally Middle part the same latter part gentle breezes with fine weather Ship lying at Anchor,

Remarks On Board Monday March 8th

First part of these 24 hours gentle breezes from NE and pleasant Middle part the same at 8 AM took the Anchor and steered to NW by N latter part gentle breezes with fine weather steering ship NW by N under all sail Upoa bearing SE 24 miles distance
