

Remarks On Board Sunday March 23rd 1858

First part of these 24 hours gentle breeze with fine weather. Mills and latter part the same ship lying at anchor starboard watch a shore on liberty

Friday April 7th 1858

This day J. W. W. Batt came on board ship Goethe as 1st Officer for the next northern whaling season. Last part of the day crew employed in putting things to rights and making preparations for sea.

Saturday April 10th

This day the Pilot came on board and took the ship outside of the harbor of Honolulu.

Sunday Apr 11th

This 24 hours ship Goethe Laying off and on at Makoo. Crew all on board except the Capt & Boy.

Tuesday April 13th

This day Capt Austin came on board and the ship proceeded on her way to the northward with a crew of 38^{men} on board all told and a fair prospect of doing well. Thus ends this day.
