Commences with fine weather
Ship heading E.S.E. Last part
of the day fresh winds from
N.W. steering S.E. by S

Wednesday Apr 21st

Begins with thick foggy weather
employed in repairing the cap
at the mainmast head
Last part of the day raining weather

Thursday April 22nd

Begins with fair weather
Last part of the thick and heavy
weather wind N.W. Ship heading
by the wind S.W. by E
