shortened sail Last part
fair weather and light air
from different quarters
thus ends the day

First part of this 24 hours
Begins with fair weather
saw right whales lowered
the boats but soon came
foggy last part of the day
fresh gales and thick weather

Begins with strong
gales from N. by W. last
part of the day moderate weather
saw no whales

Saturday May 8th

Begins with light air
Ship heading N. by E
Last part of the day calm weather

Lat 57: 45

Long 144: 06

Sunday May 9th

This 24 hours
Begins with fine weather
saw Ship Brooklyn
take a whale but saw
none ourselves
Last part of the
day fine weather
thus ends —
