May 31st

Begins with light air and fine weather. Last part of the day light winds saw whales. Lowered the boats without success.

June 1st

Begins with fine weather. Last part of the day fresh winds from E saw plenty of whales. Lowered the boats struck one. Irons drawn Mount Fairweather 30 miles distant so ends the day.

June 2nd

Begins with blowing at Gale of wind from E.S.E. Ship hove to. Last part of the day strong gales and thick weather.

June 3rd

Begins with strong winds from P.E. Ship under short-sail. Last part of the day fresh winds and heavy weather. Saw Mount Fairweather bearing N.N.E. also saw whales. Lowered the boats struck one and framed.

Friday June 4th

This day begins with light winds and thick weather. Last part of the day spoke Ship Rainbow also Ship to Morgan.

Saturday June 5th

This 24 hours calm weather. Saw 6 Ships too boiling but saw no whales. Mount Fairweather bearing N.N.E. 30 miles distant. Lat 58. 54

Sunday June 6th

This day fine weather. Saw whales. Lowered the boats struck two whales one the Iron. Drawed one Iron broke at dark shortened sail. Saw eight Ships as well as the Land bearing N.N.E. 30 miles distant.

Monday June 7th

Begins with fair weather. Saw whales. Lowered the boats without success. Last part of the day saw whales. Lowered struck cut land.
