Thursday June 24th

Begins with light winds from the westward Last part of the day thick and rising weather wind still to the S.W

Friday June 25th

This day begins with fine weather ship on different tracks by the wind working to the westward saw Humpback whales as well as the Plumegan Islands

Saturday June 26th

This day begins with light airs said Island near by lowered two boats pulled in near the shore and caught two hundred Cod Fish Barque Sava seen by this ends this day

Sunday June 27th

Begins with fine weather wind N.E. Ship steering W.S.W Land 30 miles distant Latter part of the day light and from the westward

Monday June 28th

This day begins with light winds steering N.W. Saw a burning mountain to the Eastward of the Straits Last part of the day light winds from N.E. Ship making the best of her way for Onemac Straits

Tuesday June 29th

Begins with strong winds from the Eastward Ship steering through the Strait above mentioned into Bristol Bay in company with Barque Sava Latter part of the day succeeded in getting through
