

Thursday July 8<sup>th</sup>

Begins with strong  
winds from S.W. Ship heading  
N.W. and thick weather  
Lagged the ship at 12 o'clock  
to be 15 miles west from  
St Lawrence Island  
Last part of the day thick  
fog ship heading N.W. by W.

Friday July 9<sup>th</sup>

Begins with  
strong winds from S.W.  
Ship heading N.W. by W.  
Last part of the day steered  
S. S.W. wind S.E. &  
28 fathoms of water thick  
weather bore the ship to  
with main topsail set back

Saturday July 10<sup>th</sup>

at daylight  
this morning saw ten ships  
as well as St Lawrence Island  
and the main land to the westward  
also from Indian Point came  
three canoes with a small quantity  
of whale bone which was  
purchased by the Capt.

Sunday July 11<sup>th</sup>

Begins with  
strong winds from N.E.  
ship working to the northward  
last part of the day fresh  
gale from N.E. saw several  
ships working through  
Bering Straits

Monday July 12<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light  
winds from N.E.  
Last part of the day  
steered into St Lawrence Bay  
and anchored in 20 fathoms of water

Tuesday July 13<sup>th</sup>

This day fine  
weather ship laying to anchor  
in St Lawrence Bay boats  
off in search of whales but saw none

Wednesday 14

Begins with thick fog  
weather went on shore for water  
Last part took on board eight  
casks of water
