

Thursday July 13th

This day took the anchor and left St Lawrence Bay for sea saw several ships in course of the day but none of them whaling

Friday July 14th

Began with light winds from NNE last part saw two ships steering to the Southwest direct from the Bay Bevier but reports seeing no whales

Saturday July 15th

Began with light winds saw several ships but none whaling last part of the day anchored the ship near Cape E in 20 fathoms of water saw several ships at anchor also

Sunday July 16th

Began with strong winds from N.W. the chain broke and lost a small anchor last part of the day blowing strong came to anchor again with the starboard Bower anchor

Monday July 17th

This 24 hours laying to anchor boats in shore in search of whales strong winds from N.E. this ends the day
Sat 66:10

Tuesday July 20th

Began with blowing strong gales from NNE ship still at anchor last part thick weather and strong winds from the northwest

Wednesday July 21

This day strong gales from N.W. ship at anchor saw one whale going fast to the north

Thursday July 22nd

Began with strong winds and thick weather last part moderate saw two whales going fast to the north

Friday July 23rd

This day weighed anchor and went to the northwest latter part passed Bhering Strait bound north fine weather wind N.W. so ends
