but saw no whales

Tuesday July 27th

This 24 hours
strong gales from S.W. & W.
saw one whale but too
rough to lower the boats

Wednesday July 28th

Begins with strong
winds from S.W. & W. Last part
of the day fine weather
saw 4 Ships but no whales

Thursday July 29th

This 24 hours light
winds from the north
Ship making the best of her
way for S.E. Cape but the
Prognosis is slow owing to
northerly winds

Lat 68 07

Friday July 30th

Begins with
thick fog and fresh winds
from S.E. Last part of
the day thick weather
Judged the Latitude to be 70 00

Saturday July 31st

This 24 hours
fresh breeze from S.E. and thick fog
Ship under short sail
tack & tack working to the eastward
Judged the Lat 70:45

Sunday the Aug 1st

Commences with
strong winds and rugged weather
Last part of the day spoke
Ship Robornia also saw
Cape Lisborn bearing S.E. 20
miles dist
