Tuesday Aug 3rd This day begins

S.W. Last part of the day
thick weather Ship heading on
different tracks

Wednesday Aug 4th

This 24 hours
Begin with light winds
from the north saw several
Ships steering to the Southward
Last part of the day steering S.E.
for Cape East thick fog so ends

Thursday August 5th

Begin with
light winds from the north
Last part of the day saw
Ship Menken also saw East Cape

Friday Aug 6th

Began with strong winds
from N.E. Last part of the day
steered the Ship S.P.E. and passed
Cape East Blowing a gale of wind from
N.N.E.

Saturday Aug 7th

This day begins
With fresh gales from the north
Ship under short sail laying
off St. Lawrence Bay
Last part more moderate
Spoke French Ship Jason
Lat 65° 36

Sunday Aug 8th

Begin with fine weather
and light winds from N.W.
 Latter part of the day saw Humphreys whale
Lowered the Boats struck one and killed
and sunk him
Also had a Boat stove by the whale
and a man drowned
by the name of Peter Wilson
Lat 65° 42

Monday Aug 9th

This day fine weather
saw seven Ships all working
to the north through Bhering Strait
Last part of the day saw
Humphreys whale lowered the Boats
and took one to the Ship
and cut him in
Ship Goethe heading N.N.E.
through Bhering Strait
Lat 65° 52
