employed in Boiling
Sat 69.54

Thursday 26th

Begins with fine weather
saw whales Lowered the Boats
struck one then dived
Last part of the day finished Boiling
the whale

Friday Aug 27th

Begins with fair weather
all hands employed in storing
down oil last part light winds from
S.E. but saw no whales

Saturday Aug 28th

Begins with calm weather
Last part of the day fresh winds
and rainy weather spoke Ship Splan
also Barge Helen miss
