Begins with strong
winds from N.E. crew employed
in washing ship
Last part of the day fresh
gale from N.W. ship under short sail

Monday Aug 28th

This day strong
winds from N. steering S.W.
Saw ice and two whales
but too rough to lower the boats

Tuesday Aug 29th

Begins with
strong winds from N.E.
saw several ships last part
of the 24 hours saw whales
lowered the boats and took
one to the ship and cut him in

Wednesday ~~Aug 30th~~ Sept 1st

This day begins
with strong winds from
N.W. and thick weather
Last part of the day rainy weather

Thursday Sept 2nd

Begins with fine
weather crew employed in boiling and
the whale. Latter part of the day
spoke ship open and gained
also spoke brig. Made
Latitude 68.26

Friday Sept 3rd

This day begins
with fine weather. whalers employed
in boiling and the whale.
Last part of the day thick
foggy weather wind from the S.E.
Ship working to the westward

Saturday Sept 4th

First part of this day
finished boiling the whale. Last
part strong winds from the north
and thick weather

Sunday Sept 5th

This day begins
with fresh gales from
N.E. and thick fog
Last part of the day
strong gale ship heading N.W.
wind N.W.
