Thursday Sept 9th

Begins with fair weather
saw Cape George bearing S.W.
Last part of the day spoke
Bergs Blackwater
fine weather thus ends the day

Friday Sept 10th

This day fine weather
steering E by N for East Cape
all hands employed
in stowing down oil
so ends the day

Saturday Sept 11th

This 24 hours fine weather 1882
and light air from S.W.
Crew employed in repairing sails
Cape East in sight bearing S.E.
40 mile dist

This day fine weather
and calm saw the Diomedes
Islands also saw Cape East

Monday Sept 13th

Begins with fine
weather Cape East 50 miles dist
Last part of the day
took on board 8 casks of water
from Cape East

Tuesday Sept 14th

Begins with fresh
winds from S.E. and thick weather
Ship making the best of her
way to the Southward
Last part of the day
calm weather
