

Wednesday Sept 15th

Begins with
blowing a strong gale from
S.E. and thick fog
Last part of the day thick
weather ship under short sail

Thursday Sept 16th

This 24 hours
blows a gale of wind from S.E.
and thick fog weather
Ship on different tacks carrying
all sail possible to keep
clear of the land

Friday Sept 17th

Begins with clear weather
and strong winds from the
South Cape East 10 miles distant
Latter part of the day moderate
weather but the wind still to the South
consequently we steered off S.W.
Lat 66° 12'

Saturday Sept 18th

Begins with
blowing a fresh gale
from the South steering
N by E. Last part of
the day here ship to
it blowing a gale
from South Lat 66° 38'

Sunday Sept 19th

Begins with blowing
a gale of wind from the
South Last part the same
Ship here to under short sail

Monday Sept 20th

This day begins
with strong winds from S.E.
Spoke Ship Omega
beginning latter part of the 24 hours
fresh winds from the same quarter

Tuesday Sept 21st

Begins with blowing
a furious gale of wind from
the southward Last part of
the 24 hours more moderate
but still blowing a gale

Wednesday Sept 22nd

This day fresh gales
from the South Ship under
Double R Topsails Last part of the day
saw the South of Key Cape

Thursday Sept 23rd

Begins with
blowing a strong gale from
the South Last part of
the day thick weather
