miles dist bearing W. by N.

has the Scurvy quite bad

Monday Oct 4th

Begin with strong gales
and thick fog Last part of the day
Ship under short sail it blowing
a strong gale from S. E

Tuesday Oct 5th

Begin with fresh
winds from South Last part
saw S. I. Mathews Island
bearing S. E. Last part of the day
saw one Right Whale
Lowered the Boat and captured him
took to the Ship and cut him in

Wednesday Oct 6th

Begin with strong
Gales from S. E. and thick weather.
Latter part of the day blowing a gale
of wind and thick rainy weather

Thursday Oct 7th

This 24 hours begins
with with blowing strong winds
from S. W. Steering Ship S. E. passed
near said Island also saw two Right
Whales Latter part fresh gale
steering S. E. Watcher employed
at Boiling out the
thus ends the 24 hours
