Monday Nov 15th

Tuesday Nov 16th
 Crew employed
 stowing water

Wednesday 17th
 This day the crew
 that were entitled
 to their discharge
 went on shore
 and were discharged
 from the ship before the
 Bremen Council

Thursday Nov 18th
 This day employed
 in painting ship

19th Nov
 half of the men on shore
 the others employed
 painting ship
