

December 20 1858

Tuesday

Came with light winds from N.E. the ship ready for sea at 10 am J. G. Warrington came on board ship together as 1st officer at 11 am sea account the pilot came on and took the ship outside the port of Honolulu and wind S.W.

December 21

Wednesday

Came with light winds from S.W. a lying off and on middle and latter part strong winds and rainy weather from S.

Thursday

Came with strong winds and thick rainy weather from S. a lying off and on the Captain on shore middle and latter part calm.

Friday

Came with calms at 4 pm light winds from N.E. a lying off and on middle part brisk winds at noon the Captain came on board and put a way steering S.E.

Saturday

Came with light winds from N.E. steering S.E. employed stowing anchors and chain middle and latter part the same.

December

Sunday

Came with light winds from N.E. steering S.E. by S employed at various jobs about ship middle and latter part squally.

Monday

Came with brisk winds from E. by S steering S.E. middle part squally latter part employed painting the harbour boat and wetting hole.

Tuesday

Came with light winds from E. steering S.E. employed at ship's duty middle and latter part thick squally weather.

Wednesday

Came with strong winds and squally weather from E. heading S.E. at 1 pm took in the flying jib fore and mizzen top gallant sails and single reefed the fore top sail middle part the same at 4 pm made all sail and light winds from E.

Thursday

Came with light winds from E. steering S. by E. employed painting boat and rigging middle part the same latter part light winds and variable attendance with rain squalls.
