weather from S to S S E Lat 39 = 09 S
Long 181 = 16 E

Came with light squalls from S S E
made all sail on the eastern tack
at 7 Pm wore ship to S W middle part
the same latter part wind from E S E
Lat 39 = 57 S
Long 181 = 22 E

Tuesday

Came with brisk winds from E S E heaving
S employed setting up the starboard fore
and main again middle part the same
at noon the wind hauled to S S wore ship
to E Lat 41 = 08 S
Long 182 = 32 E

Wednesday

Came with strong winds from S S E heaving
E middle and latter part the same
Lat 40 = 35 S
Long 181 = 10 E

27

Thursday

Came with strong gales from S S E a lying
to under a double reef main top sail and
fore sail middle part the same latter
part light airs and hazy weather from
S Lat 40 = 44 S
Long 181 = 49 E

Friday

Came with light winds from S heaving
E S employed reefing sails middle part
thick rainy weather latter part strong
winds from S W steering S E by S
Lat 41 = 47 S
Long 180 = 59 E

Saturday

Came with strong winds from S W steering
S E by S middle part the same latter
part moderate weather Lat 43 = 15 S
Long 180 = 08 E

30

Sunday

Came with light winds from S W by S
steering S E by S under all sail middle
part the same latter part light winds
from N steering E S E Lat 44 = 25 S
Long 188 = 55 W

31

Monday

Came with light winds from N steering E
S E at sun dawn took in sail middle part
cabin at day light made sail with light
winds from S by E heaving E by S
Lat 45 = 01 S
Long 188 = 04 W

Tuesday

Came with light winds from S by E on the
eastern tack at 7 Pm thick rainy weather
took in sail middle part the same latter
part more moderate under whole top sails
spoke the ship Franklin of New Bedford
culling a 90 lb sperm whale Lat 45 = 05 S
Long 186 = 36 W

Wednesday

Came with brisk winds from S S E under whole
top sails at 3 Pm made pinacle rock middle
and latter part the same
