Came with brisk gales from S.W. under double reefed top sails on the southern tack at sun down took in sail wore ship to W.S.W. middle part calm latter part light winds from S steering N.E.

Came with light winds from S steering N.E. at 5 P.M. lowered the boats for sperm whales the harbour boat got one at 8 P.M. took him along side took in sail to a close reef main top sail middle and latter part a blowing a smart gale got up the cutting gear & got ready for cutting

Came with strong gales from S a lying to under a close reefed main top sail with a whale alongside middle part the same at 5 P.M. more moderate hooked on and came cutting got the jaw and the cutting pendant parted made a new one of cordage ends with strong gales from S.W.

the 8

Tuesday

Came with strong gales from S.W. to rugged to cut at 8 P.M. took in the main top sail middle and latter part the same

Lat 49 = 49 S

Long 174 = 06 W

the 9

Wednesday

Came with strong gales from S.W. a lying to under a main spencer with the whale alongside middle part moderate at 8 P.M. came cutting ends with light winds from N.E.

Lat 45 = 00 S

Long 174 = 05 W

Thursday

Came with light winds and thick weather from N.E. employed cutting at 4 P.M. got through and made sail steering W.S.W. middle part the same latter part strong from N.W. under double reefed top sails employed killing

Lat 45 = 16 S

Long 175 = 10 W

the 11

Friday

Came with strong winds from N.W. had to the western employed killing middle and latter part strong gales from N.W. a lying to under a close reefed main top sail

Lat 45 = 33 S
