

Tuesday Feb <sup>th</sup> 1 comes with light  
Breuses from the N and varying East  
erly Schr heading to the Eastward  
with whales in sight and boats on  
chases at 6 got on board with out  
sueses middle and latter part strong  
Breuses from the Eastward heading to  
the North daylight wore round and headed  
to South wind varying South So ends

Wednesday Feb <sup>th</sup> 2 comes with strong  
winds from the S E by S heading S W  
at 2 P M wore round and headed East  
at sunset took in sail middle and  
latter part fresh gales from the West  
ward steering E at 11 P M left to  
on the Starboard tack at 8 A M carried  
away the flying at 8.30 crossed a large  
heading to the N So ends

Thursday Feb 3 comes with strong  
Westerly gales Schr heading to the  
Eastward middle and latter part  
strong winds from the N E heading to  
the Eastward at 3 A M wore round and  
headed S by W at 10 A M kept off W S W  
one sail in sight So ends

Friday Feb <sup>th</sup> 4 comes with strong  
winds from East steering S W a general  
sail middle and latter part strong  
Breuses from Southward steering S W

Saturday Feb <sup>th</sup> 5 comes with strong  
Breuses from the S with clear weather  
steering S W by W at sunset took in  
the mainsail middle part light and  
calms with rain latter part strong  
Breuses and rain squalls from the S E  
steering S W So ends

Sunday <sup>th</sup> 6 comes with  
strong Breuses from the S E steering  
S W by W middle and latter part strong  
Breuses from the S E at 11 P M hove to  
on the Port tack at daylight kept off  
S W by W So ends

Monday <sup>th</sup> 7 comes with strong  
Breuses and hazy weather from the  
S E steering S W by W at 2 P M rain  
bakers and wore round and headed  
E N E middle and latter part light  
Breuses from the Eastward heading to  
North at 9 A M tacked ship and headed  
S E So ends

Tuesday <sup>th</sup> 8 comes with light  
Breuses from the East heading to the  
South at 2 P M took in the mainsail  
middle and latter part wind and  
weather much the same Schr heading on  
different tacks So ends

Wednesday <sup>th</sup> 9 comes with light  
Breuses and rain squalls from the N E  
by N heading E at 3 P M took in the main  
sail one sail in sight middle and  
latter part moderate Breuses from the  
N E heading to the S at daylight  
made sail and headed S one sail  
in sight So ends
