

Thursday Febth 10 comes with
light breezes from N.E. steering South
at 3 P.M. tack'd Ship and headed
N by W at 5 P.M. took in sail middle
and latter part calm at 7 A.M. ran
and black fish and load the boats
S.B. struck and one fish So ends

Lat 22.58 Lon 78.41
Friday Febth 11 comes with
light and calm bids easterly
heading to the Westward middle
and latter part wind and weather
much the same at 7 A.M. load the
boats for black fish at 9 A.M. returned
with out success 19 sails in sight the
watch employed boring black fish So ends

Lat 22.44 Lon 78.58
Saturday Febth 12 comes with
light Breezes bids E.N.E. steering
N.W. Several sails in sight middle
and latter part fresh breezes from N.E.
steering N.W. with all sail out at
7 A.M. got up cables and bent them
So ends

Sunday Febth 13 comes with
moderate breezes bids E.N.E. steering
N by N at 3 P.M. made the land at
6 P.M. came to anchor at 7 P.M.
tack'd tug Boat at 7 P.M. came to anchor
in fernadina middle and latter part
wind and weather much the same
So ends

Monday Febth 14 comes with moderate
from the S.E. at 7 A.M. took anchor and
came close in and let go all hands employ
breaking out oil latter part squally and
heavy rain from the S.W. So ends

Tuesday Febth 15 comes with strong
and rain from S.W. laing to anchor in fernadina
all hands employed steering the
hole latter part like breezes from the N.W.
So ends

Wednesday Febth 16 comes with light
breezes from the N.W. at 6 A.M. hauled
along side of the steamer and discharged
the oil all hands employed in ships duty
latter part wind and weather the same
So ends

Thursday Febth 17 comes with
light breezes from N.W. laing to anchor
in fernadina All hands employed in
ships duty latter part light breezes
from N.E. So ends

Friday Febth 18 comes
with light breezes and clear weather
from the N.E. laing to anchor in
fernadina latter part wind and
weather about the same So ends

Saturday Febth 19
comes with moderate breezes bids N
laing to anchor at 7 A.M. got under
way and beat out at 12 N port left
So ends

Sunday Febth 20 comes with
moderate breezes bids N. Schreder beating
off shore at 3 P.M. took in sail and
headed to the N.W. at 5 P.M. wore round
and to N.E. wind hauled to the W at 7
light bearing N.W. by W middle and
latter part fresh breezes from the
N.E. with clear weather Schreder heaving
on different tacks under short
sail So ends
