Tuesday Febth 22 comes with moderate breezes and thick weather. Scher heading on different tacks at 5 P.M. got in flying jibboom and rigged all. Another.

Wednesday Febth 23 comes with light varying winds and thick weather. Scher heading on different at 5 P.M. came to anchor off the light in eight fathoms water middle and latter part moderate breezes and rainy. being to anchor.

Thursday Febth 24 comes with moderate breezes and clear weather. Scher heading to anchor off the light middle and latter part fresh gales from N.E. at 4 P.M. moderate.

Friday Febth 25 comes with moderate breezes from N.E. being to anchor at 3 P.M. raised a right whale. The boats S.B. struck and saved him middle and latter part fine weather at daylight got up cutting gear and commenced cutting at 12 o'clock.

Saturday Febth 26 comes with light winds from W.S.W. with clear weather. All hands employed with taking care of the whale middle and latter part fine weather at 11 A.M. started the works.

Sunday Febth 27 comes with light breezes and clear weather from the Westward being to anchor. Boiling middle and latter part light air and breeze from the Eastward being to anchor. Boiling.

Monday Febth 28 comes with calm being to anchor. Boiling at 5 P.M. got thru boiling and the watch middle and latter part light westerly winds at 1 P.M. board the boats and chased a right whale.

Tuesday Febth 29 comes with fresh breezes from the Westward being to anchor off fernandina boats chasing whales at 5 P.M. got on board middle and latter part moderate breezes from the Westward at 7 P.M. board the boats and chased.

Wednesday March 1 comes with moderate breezes from the N.W. middle and latter part about the same all hands employed working in the rig at.

Thursday March 2 comes with strong breeze thick weather from the S.W. being to anchor off fernandina light at 1 P.M. sent the boat on shore for letters middle and latter part strong westward wind.
