

Friday Mar 24th Comes with light breezes from the Eastward. Scher heading to the South under short sail all hands employed taking care of oil a middle and latter part moderate breezes from South East. So ends

Saturday Mar 25th Comes with strong winds from S.E. Scher under short sail at 12.30 wore round and headed to the North under fore sail middle and latter part about the same

Lat 27.48 Lon 78.40

Sunday Mar 26th Comes with moderate breezes and a heavy swell from the South Scher heading to the Eastward under short sail middle part heavy rain squalls latter part light winds from the Westward Scher heading to the South at 11 A.M. made land and headed for it. So ends

Lat 27.50 Lon 78.01 W

Monday Mar 27th Comes with light winds and clear weather from the N.W. at 1 P.M. we tacked ship and headed to the N.E. at 7 P.M. took in sail and headed N.E. middle and latter part light air and calm Scher heading to the North under short sail at daylight raised black and board the boats and seen nothing more of them and came aboard and the watch went to work mending sails. So ends

Lat 27.35 Lon 77.48 W

Tuesday Mar 28th Comes with light winds from the E.N.E. Scher heading N.W. at sun set took in sail and headed N.W. middle and latter part strong winds from the South Scher heading to the Eastward at 10 A.M. wore round and reefed the fore sail. So ends

Lat 25.08 Lon 78.35 W

Wednesday Mar 29th Comes with strong gales from the South Scher heading to the Westward under two reefs fore sail middle part strong from S.W. gales from W.S.W. Scher heading to the Port tack under close reef fore sail latter part moderated at 5 A.M. wore round. So ends

Lat 25.02 Lon 79.05 W

Thursday Mar 30th Comes with strong breezes from the W.S.W. Scher heading S.E. at 7 P.M. wore round and headed N.W. middle and latter part light breezes from the Westward Scher heading to the South under short sail at daylight made sail and headed S by W. at 10 A.M. kept E.S.E. So ends

Lat 27.58 Lon 78.21 W

Friday Mar 31th Comes with light breezes from the Westward steering E.S.E. Scher under all sail at 4 P.M. took in the main sail middle and latter part light air and calms Scher heading to the Eastward at 10 A.M. got a little breeze and made sail and headed S by E. So ends
