

Saturday June 10 comes with strong breezes from the E steering N by W at sunset took in sail middle and latter part wind and after sunset the same heading to the N at daylight made sail and were round. So ends

Sunday June 11th comes with strong winds and squally weather from the South heading to the West at 4 P.M. heavy rain and calm middle part light winds and squally latter part light wind from the S heading to the Eastward. So ends

Monday June 12th comes with light breezes and clear weather from the South steering heading ESE under all sail middle part light wind latter part light wind and rain squalls heading to the Eastward. So ends

Tuesday June 13th comes with light winds and rain squalls varying from E to W at 4 P.M. took in the main sail at sunset bids ESE heading ESE middle and latter part about the same. So ends

Wednesday June 14th comes with light winds and rain squalls from the South heading to the S by E sails in sight at 1 P.M. Spoke S by E and some recuties from the middle and latter part light breeze and squally at 10 A.M. tack ship. So ends

Thursday June 15th comes with light winds and cloudy weather heading to the ESE at sunset took in sail middle and latter part light breeze and clear weather bids SE heading ESE sails in sight. So ends

Friday June 16th comes with light breezes from the S by E heading E by S at 4 P.M. tack ship and headed S by middle and latter part wind and after the same steering heading S by W by W at 7 P.M. tack ship. So ends

Saturday June 17th comes with light winds and calm heading to the Eastward middle and latter part light winds and calms steering heading to the Eastward at 6 A.M. raise the island of Cuba. So ends

Sunday June 18th comes with light winds from the S by E steering heading E by N at 7 P.M. under all sail at 7 P.M. and bearing S. one sail in sight middle and latter part wind and after the same steering E by N with all sail out. So ends

Monday June 19th comes with winds from the N steering E by N at 4 P.M. raised the driblet headed shot key light and up by the wind and headed N by E middle and latter part calm at 5 P.M. raised a long sperm whale, S.B. went on and struck and brand and came aboard. So ends
