Tuesday Aug 20th
1833

This 24 hours squally with a light breeze from the East all hands employed in breaking out water and stowing it between Decks at 2 P.M. spoke Ship Cadmus of Sagharbour no Oil Lat 28° 40'

Wednesday Aug 21th
1833

This 24 hours fine all hands employed in fitting cutting gear Lat 30° 10'

Thursday Aug 22th
1833

This 24 hours fine saw several Finbacks Bent a Storm Mizen and Fore Trysail Lat 32° 15'

Friday Aug 23th
1833

This 24 hours squally with a strong breeze from the W. at 9 a.m. spoke the Ship ~~Home~~ Ferry of New London with 3000 ~~Shame~~
