

Monday Dec 23th
1833

This 24 hours fine at 9 A.M. Spoke
Ship Delta of Greenport 1050 B of Oil
with 2 large Whales alongside that she
took the night before At 11 O'clock raised
Whales lowered and got one to the Bow
Boat Spoke Ship Jasper of Boston wanting
one Whale. Lat 57° 30'
Long 1 10 E

Tuesday Dec 24th
1833

This 24 hours fine weather saw no
Whales Capt caught a porpoise
Course N.E. W.

Wednesday Dec 25th
1833

This 24 hours very thick foggy
weather saw nothing so ends this day
Lat 57° 20'

Thursday Dec 26th
1833

This 24 hours thick spoke the Jasper
at 4 A.M. Lighted up and saw
Whales lowered and the second mate
got fast the Irons drewed the
Jasper sunk one the same time
Lat 57° 30'
Long 1 30

Friday Dec 27th
1833

This 24 hours thick with a strong
breeze from the North at 4 P.M.
cleared up saw a great many fish
lowered but so rugged did not
get fast

Saturday Dec 28th
1833

This 24 hours thick with strong
Winds at 11 A.M. lighted up
saw Whales lowered the Boats
and the mate got fast and got
the Whale to Spouting thick blood
it came in thick we lost sight of the
Ship and did not find her till
3 P.M.

Sunday Dec 29th
1833

This 24 hours thick saw nothing
in company with Jasper
Lat 58° 00'
Long 2° 00'

Monday Dec 30th
1833

These 24 hours thick weather at
6 P.M. got a Whale to the B.R.

Tuesday Dec 31st

These 24 hours rainy got a Whale
and cut him in at 6 P.M. got
another Lat 57° 48'
Long 1° 00'

Wednesday Jan 1st
1834

These 24 hours cut in a Whale
Spoke Ship Albion 10 Whales
at 4 P.M. got another Whale

Thursday Jan 2nd

These 24 hours fine cut in our
Whale and got another and cut
him in on Deck saw 2 Ships
with Colours set fore and left
the Jasper and 3 Pike full of men

Friday Jan 3rd

These 24 hours rugged saw nothing
all hands employed in Bailing and
Stowing down

Saturday Jan 4th

These 24 hours rugged Spoke Ship
Wheeler of Sagharboub 1400 B of
Oil saw one whale lowered
chase without success
Lat 58° 40'
Long 1° 56'

Sunday Jan 5th

These 24 hours light winds employed
in Bailing and Stowing Pipes between
Decks
Lat 58° 51'
