Remarks on board Tuesday sep 3rd 20
Strong breeze from southward steering
O by N half N at 6 in the morning raised
anchors & lowered the boats but did not
strike about 10 & 11 boats came on
board at 12 raised them again lowered
and struck on at him all on side at 6
P M Lat 40° 10' N Long 33° 17' W

Remarks Wednesday Sep 4th 21 days out
Strong breeze from Westward
employed in cutting in saw nothing

Remarks on board Thursday sep 5th 22 d
All this day strong breeze from
Westward fore part finished cutting in
after part commenced trying out

Remarks on board Friday sep 6th 23 days out
Strong breeze from Northward steering O by N
employed in trying out saw nothing

Remarks on board sep 7th 24 days out
Strong breeze from Southward
starting by the wind raised land in the
morning finished trying out and
broke out after hole passed Cape about
3 P M at 6 spoke the Sagoda of
New Bedford 2 months out with 90000 lbs

Remarks Sunday sep 8th 25 days out

Moderate breeze from the westward
going off and on to Floris about 7
in the morning Capt went on shore
about 6 in the evening came on board
going off and on all night

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Remarks on board Monday sep 9th 26 d

Light breeze from the westward

Boat went on shore about 7 in
the morning. Employed in cooping the
oil about 1 P M bim boat came off with
a load of potatoes pumpkins onions &c
left 2 passengers and shipped 4 men
boat came on board about sunset
Capt stayed ashore all night

Remarks sep 10th 27 days out from home

All this day light breeze from the westward

About 2 P M Capt came off in a
shore boat and brought some more
pumpkins onions &c bore away for
Brazil employed in setting up rigging
saw two sails

Remarks Wednesday sep 11th 28 days out

Strong breeze from the westward steering
for Brazil at 2 P M raised land and
hauled back the head yards and luffed
to the wind about day light kept off and
stood in for the passage about 8 A M
howe aback off the town the Sagoda and
three bars lying off and on about 2 P M
a shore boat came off with a load of pump
cabbages onions melons grapes &c about
sunset boat came on board and left Capt
a shore boat out to the Eastward of the
passage and layed off and on all night
blowing strong doubled reefed topsails
& took in mainsail & jib during the night
