Remarks on board Thursday Sept 12th
Strong breeze from westward about
11 A.M. moderated and stood in to the
passage about 12 A.M. hauled back and
Mr. Ellison went on shore at 2 P.M.
a shore boat came off and took the oil
at 3 P.M. boat came on board & Mr. Milton
went on shore and stayed all night
at sunset boat came on board and
brought Capt. stood out to seaward of
passage and layed off and on all night

Remarks Friday Sept 13th 31 days out
about 7 A.M. hauled back off the town
and Capt. went on shore lying off and on
all day at sunset boat came on board &
brought Capt. & Mr. Milton stood out to
west of the passage & hauled to the southeast.

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 14th 32 days out
light breeze from Northward southward at
9 A.M. luff to the wind with the larboard
tacks aboard about sunset spoke the Legrange
of Matapisset Capt. Elanders. Capt. B. came on
board and stayed till 9 in the evening

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 15th 33 days out
light breeze from the Northward steering
by the wind with larboard tacks aboard
at 9 A.M. Capt. went on board the
Legrange and gammed until 10 P.M.

Remarks on board Monday Sept 16th 34 days out
light breeze from Northward steering by the
Capt. B. came on board spoke the Gem of Beverly
at 3 P.M. long 26.24

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 17th 35

light breeze from N. ward steering by
the wind about 8 A.M. raised whales
to the windward and lowered three
boats and pulled after them about
11 raised one on the starboard
quarter about 1/2 mile off lowered
the starboard boat and struck him
he stove the boat & broke three oars
he then layed about 20 minutes
and sounded and took all the line
but about 3 or 4 fathoms we then
held on hard and hove drew the first
iron and parted the short warp
the boats then came on board and
got dinner after dinner lowered
again and chased until sunset

Remarks Wednesday Sept 18 35 days out

light breeze from N. and Eastward
at 7 A.M. raised whales on the
lee bow lowered and chased all
day but did not strike at sunset
boats came on board took in sail
and set boats crew watches took in
starboard boat for wind saw two
sails at 32.05 N.

Remarks Thursday Sept 19 36 days out

light breeze from N. & Westward steering
by the wind with the starboard tacks
aboard at 10 A.M. raised whales lowered
and must boat struck & turned up once
got him along side about 1/2 dark took in
sail. and set boats crew watches
at 32.33 N.
