Light breeze from Northward commenced cutting in at daylight finished cutting in about 8 A.M. at 10 raised whale boards chased but did not get fast at 4 P.M. commenced trying at lat $32^{\circ}43'N$ long $24^{\circ}51'$

Remarks Saturday Sept 21st 36 days out

Light breeze from Northward saw a sail finished trying about sunset took in sail & set both crew watches lat $32^{\circ}12'$

Remarks Sunday Sept 22nd 37 days out
Light breeze from Northward steering S. by E. saw nothing lat $32^{\circ}13'N$ long $23^{\circ}15'$

Remarks on board Monday Sept 23rd 38 days out
Light breeze from the Northward steering South saw a sail

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 24th 39 days out
Light breeze from the Eastward steering so employed in stowing down oil saw two sails. Lat $29^{\circ}58'N$ long $24^{\circ}24'$

Remarks on board Wednesday Sept 25th 40 days out
Light breeze from Eastward steering South spoke the Columbus of Bremen bound to New Orleans with emigrants

Remarks Thursday Sept 26th 41 days out
Strong breeze from N.E. steering South look out for water set up jib gins

Remarks Friday Sept 27th 42 days out
Strong breeze from N.E. steering South at 10 saw single reefed topsail saw nothing

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Remarks Saturday Sept 28th 43 days out

Strong breeze from N.E. steering South saw 1 porpoise

Remarks Sunday Sept 29th 44 days out

Strong breeze from N.E. steering South saw nothing at sunset took in sail expecting to see land in the morning

Remarks on board Monday Sept 30th 45 days out
Moderate breeze from N.E. steering West at 6 A.M. raised Banavita on the weather beam at 3 P.M. raised Mage raised on the larboard bow at sunset land on the starboard bow

Remarks Tuesday Oct 1st 46 days out
Light breeze from N.E. steering South about 10 A.M. Capt went on shore at Mage stayed about 2 hours & came on board & kept off for Pigeon at 5 P.M. passed port Pigeon

Remarks Wednesday Oct 2nd 47 days out
Light breeze from N.E. steering for Pigeon raised land at daylight stood around on south side of the island at 2 P.M. Capt went on shore at 5 P.M. took strong breeze took in all hands sails double reefed topsails boat came on board at dark North four hours left Capt on shore
