Moderate breeze from eastward with fog
fore part natives came on board to trade
latter part chased whale jammed with the
Paravian

Remarks June 29th 11th day
Fore part light breeze from eastward
with fog. latter part calm the
natives came off to trade

Remarks 29th 10 months & 4th
Strong breeze from S.W. steering to
south & westward. Saw nothing

Remarks July 1st 11th day 15th
Strong breeze from S.W. with fog
fore part lowered & chased humpback
jammed with the Roanoke of Greenport

Remarks July 2nd
Light breeze from S.W. with fog
jammed with the Coggeshall
Kantucket saw nothing

Remarks Thursday July 3rd
Moderate breeze from S.W. with rain
for some rain diminished with the
Woodward Komahatt George saw a bowhead

Remarks Friday July 4th 18 days out
Fresh breeze from S.W. steering
to eastward saw nothing. Breakfast
for dinner

Remarks July 5th
Light breeze from S.W. eastward chased
a bowhead to the land the boat
landed jammed with the Amer

Remarks July 6th 19th & 20 days out

Light breeze from westward
steering to southward chased whale
latter part jammed with the
John Mills & the Crown of New London

Remarks Sunday July 7th
Light breeze from westward steering
to north & eastward passing St. Lawrence
Island jammed with the Remond
Abraham Barker

Remarks Monday July 8th
Moderate breeze from north & eastward
all this day chased whale but did
not strike

Remarks July 9th
Strong breeze from northward
saw several high topsails coming
with the risk of San Francisco & spoke
the Hunter saw nothing

Remarks Thursday 10th
Light breeze from eastward
steering northward with some
fog. Drain lowered for whale

Remarks July 11th
Light breeze from northward & steering
into the strait latter part chased whale

Remarks July 12th
Fresh breeze from southward with a
thick fog steering to windward
