

Ship Gov. Group. P. Coggeshall Master

Remarks August 11<sup>th</sup> / 1826

Light breeze from southward standing to westward for part of forenoon latter part gannet with the Mousaw & Nona

Remarks August 12<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze from eastward off this day sailing to windward spoke the Adeline of N. B. & the Mary Ann also gannet with the Mousaw

Remarks August 13<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze from eastward steering southward all the day fair weather after part around the point of St. Lawrence  
Saw Cape Point

Remarks August 13<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze from southward standing on Starboard tack for part picked up a dead whale cut him in & boiled him out turned out 5 barrels

Remarks August 14<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze from northward being at Good Hope East raised a carcass & cut in the tongue made 6 barrels gannet with the Mousaw

Remarks August 15<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze from northward with fog for part being at Cape East at 4 P.M. coggeshall anchored round on being becalmed weather the Ann of Long Harbor

Remarks August 16<sup>th</sup>

Remarks August 16<sup>th</sup> / 1826

At 6 A.M. hoisted up & stood down along East Cape upon the Globe of N. B. ashore the bark Alman of N. B. getting her oil & provisions at 12 two boats went on board of the wreck came in a thick fog ship came to an anchor boats went on board bark

Remarks 17<sup>th</sup>  
All this day blowing a moderate gale from northward with the fog did not leave up

Remarks 18<sup>th</sup>

Two part blowing strong from N. E. with fog at 4 P.M. hoisted up ran down to the deck & boats came on board stood off tacked & stood in under the lee of East Cape and came to an anchor Capt went on board Mousaw

Remarks August 19<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze from N. E. at 7 A.M. hoisted up and steered southward for Lower bay spoke the Mount Vernon

Remarks 20<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh breeze from southward beating to the wind at 4 P.M. passing St. Lawrence bay saw 2 ships at anchor spoke the Pacific & the Charles spoke the Pacific

Remarks 21<sup>st</sup>  
At 10 saw light breeze from eastward with fog for part came in spoke to trade spoke the Russian
