Moderate breeze from northward  
steering S. by E. fore part saw a sail  
lat 33° 11' long 127°

Remarks Oct 4<sup>th</sup>  
Fore part fresh breeze from north & eastward steering S. by E.  
employed in painting & scraping the iron  
work latter part strong breeze lat 31.42

Remarks Thursday Oct 9<sup>th</sup>  
Breeze from N. by Eastward steering  
S. by E. employed in painting iron work  
latter part employed in rattling down  
the rigging saw a sail lat 25.37

Remarks Oct 10<sup>th</sup> Fore part  
fresh breeze from N. by Eastward steering  
S. by E. saw a sail all this day employed  
in rattling down a sail in sight

Remarks Oct 11<sup>th</sup> Fore  
part light breeze from N. by East steering  
S. by E. latter part light breeze from  
northward steering S. by E. lat 24.44 long 116

Remarks Oct 12<sup>th</sup> Fore part  
light breeze & calms finished rattling down  
latter part calm saw a sail lat 23.44 N  
long 115.25 71

Remarks Monday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>  
Fore part light breeze from N. by East steering  
S. by E. saw a sail latter part raised a  
school of black fish in mid & got two

Remarks Oct 14<sup>th</sup> All this day  
light breeze from N. by East steering S. employed  
scraping iron work

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lat 22.29 Remarks Thursday Oct 15<sup>th</sup>  
Comp 136 fore part light breeze from northward steering  
S. at dark changed back expecting to see land  
latter part took a lunar observation of the sun  
moon

Remarks Oct 16<sup>th</sup>  
Fore part light breeze from eastward steering  
S. by E. eastward latter part calm employed  
in scraping iron work got a lunar

Remarks Oct 17<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze & calms steering S. by E. short  
by the wind  
employed in painting & cleaning iron work  
latter part took a lunar lat 20.47 long 110

Remarks on board Oct 18<sup>th</sup> 1851  
Fore part light breeze from northward  
steering S. by E. latter part steering S. by E.  
lat 19.55 long 108

Remarks Oct 19<sup>th</sup> Fore part  
light breeze and calms beat the topmast  
shots & painted them saw whale  
breaching 5 or 6 miles off latter part  
looked for whales & killed 9 or 10 miles  
but did not see them after we lowered a

Remarks Oct 20<sup>th</sup> 1851  
All this fore part calm saw nothing  
latter part freshened the sail  
lat 19.14

Remarks Oct 21<sup>th</sup>  
fore part light breeze from all points  
of the compass with rain latter part  
strong breeze from eastward heading  
S. by E.
