S.E. saw Lullian bottomed latter
moderate breeze Capt fell overboard near
the mizzenmast lowered a boat & picked
him up lat 8° 22'

Remarks Nov 8th
Crew part light breeze from southward about
6 P.M. wind hauled ahead tacked
ship heading to south & westward latter
part nearly calm lat 8° 13'

Remarks Nov 9th
Crew part moderate breeze from N.W.
steering S.E. employed in

lacked ship heading East latter part strong

steering S.E. at 9 P.M.
was ship and by with the head of
aback expecting to see Escob. island in
the morning raised land at 8 P.M.

steering heading S.E. lat 4.22

S.E. saw nothing latter part steering
S.W. lat 3.15. Morning 3.21

Remarks Nov 14th Crew
part strong breeze from southward head
ing S.W. took out for Molokai Sugar
Apples. Breeze & wind latter part
heading S.E. lat 2.17

Remarks Nov 15th Crew
part fresh breeze from southward
heading S.E. & S. latter part hauled
out between decks saw nothing N.

Remarks Nov 16th The
part moderate breeze from south & west
ward saw a steamer bound northward
at 1 P.M. tacked ship heading N.W.
at 3 P.M. tacked again heading S.
at 11 P.M. tacked in the wind of
S.W. & hauled on our bow latter part

Remarks Nov 17th Crew part fresh
breeze from S. heading S.E. & S. hauled
for back fish struck in & drew at 4 P.M.
tacked heading N.W. latter part heading
S.E. & S. saw sail lat 3.24
