Remarks Nov 10th
The port strong breeze from southward made
S. C. by 9. Sailed this sent up the fore & main
sprit pole at 1. The fore & main
batter post came up, crossed the fore & main royal
yards about 4. A. M. were sprung up from 10 ft.
Steering S. by E. Lat 3.13

Remarks Nov 19th
The port strong breeze from southward steering
S. by E. at 4. The fore & main
the anchor off the bar & got up the chain
stood in about 10 miles from land and were
round & hauled aback. The port post fresh breeze
from northward beating to windward lat 3.28

Remarks Nov 20th The port
fresh breeze from northward about 10. The
came to an anchor off Point Mahalo. Capt
of bark Chid came on board & us latter port
towed a raft up the river & carried the cargo
up to the town

Remarks Nov 21st The port
boat came on board & left the raft to fill in
the morning rest employed in channing ship &
painting Capt stored on shore latter went on
shore & filled the raft & towed it down the river
the remainder employed in painting ship

Remarks Nov 22nd The port towed the
raft to the ship & finished painting one
side of the ship at sunset brought Capt on
board latter port brought off a boat load of
wood

Remarks Sunday Nov 23rd
In the morning starboard watch went
on shore on liberty & came off at night

All hands employed in stowing water between
decks. The port towed a raft of cargo on shore
and started off with 2 boat loads of wood
swamped two boats

Remarks Tuesday Nov 25th
Starboard watch went on liberty
starboard watch employed in filling a raft
of water the going of bark of Nantucket came
in 12 months out with 250 lbs sperm oil

Remarks Wednesday Nov 26th
Brought off a raft of water & blocked the bend
on the starboard side ship. Eagle of New York
came in 30 months out with 1000 spms. The
employed in breaking out to stow water got
off 2 boat loads of wood

Remarks Nov 27th
Watch employed in getting off wood &
stowing stowing water. The starboard
watch came on board

Remarks Friday Nov 28th
Starboard watch went on shore on liberty
starboard watch employed in getting off wood
& stowing water

Remarks Saturday Nov 29th
Watch employed in getting off wood
& emptying it up. The employed in stowing
off the fore hyle with coals & wood & in
washing ship. Boat went on shore & carried
Capt

The port hoisted main top sail top gaff
sails & jibs latter port finished the sails
and went in with the port & brought
off the watch
