First part moderate breeze heading East  
saw a finback latter part fresh breeze  
broke out for meat

First part fresh breeze heading East  
watch employed in making sinit  
at 2 o'clock saw ship latter part steering  
N.W. latter part saw finbacks covered for

Thursday Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 1852  
First part fresh breeze steering N.W. by N  
saw porpoises latter part steering  
N.W. watch employed in making sinit

Friday Jan 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Fresh breeze steering N.W. watch  
employed in making sinit latter part  
light breeze

Saturday Jan 3<sup>rd</sup>  
First part steering N.W. by N with a  
light breeze broke out for meat latter  
part all hands employed in breaking  
out water & stowing it between decks

Sunday Jan 4<sup>th</sup>  
First part light trades steering N.W. by N  
all hands employed in stowing the  
scuttle put between decks garbage & water  
the Leonidas of N. 13. 15 months out  
250 sperm latter part set top mast  
studding sail & bow away for Lalla Rookh

Monday Jan 5<sup>th</sup>  
Light trades steering N.W. by N  
latter part steering N.W. by N broke out  
for meat

Light trades steering N.W. by N
